PRINCIPAL'S REPORT (2021-22)

By the Grace of God Almighty I stand before you to present the Principal's Report for the academic year 2021-22. I was appointed as Principal of St. Thomas College, Ranni on 1st April, 2020. At the outset let me thank the Ranni Valiya Palli Educational Agency for appointing me as the Principal of the college. I am also grateful to the management and all the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college for their support and cooperation. Since 2019 I am a Research Guide of Mahatma Gandhi University. I was the Head of the Department of Zoology of St. Thomas College from 2008 to 2020 and Vice Principal from 2018 to 2020.

The college re-opened after mid-summer vacation on 1st June 2021 with 2nd and 3rd year degree and 2nd year PG classes in online mode. 1st semester UG started on 27th September 2021 and 1st semester PG started on 3rd November 2021. Regular classes in offline mode started on 20th October 2021.

At present we have 9 degree courses and 4 P G courses. Around 10 International and national seminars were conducted and many co-curricular and extracurricular activities conducted in online and offline mode. I have taken every effort to maintain the academic ambience in the college.

Even though the college faced many difficult situations due to Covid-19 pandemic, with the strong support of the management, alumni and public at large I was able to conduct the classes in online platform for all the courses and complete the syllabus well in advance before the examination.

Four non-teaching staffs were appointed during the year 2021-22. RUSA funded construction of Vayala block seminar hall and renovation of Principals room, library, football ground and cricket pitch were completed. Boy's toilet under construction. During online classes I have regularly interacted with all the students of UG and PG classes to understand their problems and difficulties in connection with the online class and immediate remedial measures were taken. A "**Helpdesk for Online classes**" was started for support students during online classes.

Integrated M.Sc programme in Computer science -Artificial intelligence and Machine learning is a new innovative and inter disciplinary programme sanctioned by the MG University. College got sanction from University Grant Commission to conduct eight diploma and certificate courses. Massive Open Online Class (MOOC) organic farming by MG University for 1st year & 2nd year students is a part of the curriculum.

I am grateful to the management for the renovation and maintenance works carried out during this period in the commerce block, old block, record room, auditorium, canteen, ladies hostel and physics lab. The functioning of the college cooperative store started again on 5th January 2022 and an office for guidance and counseling cell also started in the commerce block. Construction of bore well and

water tank in the ladies hostel, construction of two toilet for disabled was also done during this period.

The total student's strength of this year is 885 which consist of 827 students in the aided stream and 58 students in self-financing stream. The college has a well equipped Computer center and a Central Library with 35435 books, journals and magazines. Among teaching faculties 21 Ph. D degree holders and five research guides. There are 43 teaching faculties and 23 non- teaching faculties are in the college.

Ladies Hostel

We have provided hostel facilities for 61 girl students and 2 teaching faculties during this year. All necessary facilities are provided in the hostel to students for a comfortable stay and a favorable atmosphere for their studies.

Mentoring system, Value education and ethics, tutorial and remedial classes

Value education and ethics, tutorial and remedial classes are taken to lead this institution to greater heights of academic excellence. Mentoring system is introduced in order to guide students (Mentees) who are weak and those who need support.

College union election returning officer is Mr. Benny George, the Staff Advisor for the College Union is. Dr. Deepa Roselin Joeseeph, Asst. Prof. Shruthi Mariam DAVID is the faculty advisor of the Arts Club and Dr. Anu T Philip is the Magazine Staff Advisor. The College Union was inaugurated on 22nd march 2022 by Konni MLA and alumni Adv. K. U. Jenish Kumar. Arts festival conducted on 23rd March 2022, Sports day on March30th and College day on 31st March2022.

The annual sports meet of our college was conducted on 30th march 2022. Overall championship was scored by arts house. Albin Shaji off commerce house and Adhithya Sunil Kumar of science house received the individual championship.

As far as discipline is concerned, the College atmosphere had generally been peaceful. It had been teamwork and I take this opportunity to thank all the staff, teaching and

non-teaching as well as the student community, the PTA and the alumni's for their enthusiastic support and cooperation.


VIDEO MAKING ON AWARENESS OF COVID

An Inter Department Poster Designing Competition was conducted on 1stJuly,2022 – GST Day.




ENGLISH ASSOCIATION

MASSIVE OPEN ONLINE COURSE (MOOC)

MOOC Course on Organic Farming is offered to all students doing first year UG Programmes in the College as added credit course. The course is structured in

accordance with the regulations of UGC for Online courses and it is made compulsory by the University. The course spread across first and second semester of the UG Programme. The Course has 14 Modules including 2 Projects. The 4 credits of this course will be given in addition to the Total credits of UG Programmes existing now.

260 students registered for MOOC course during the year. Each student will be provided with username and password, by using which the course content can be accessed. Even though the programme is offered as an online course, the course has a practical component to it (one project for first and second semester). For the first semester project student asked to cultivate any 5 crop like Bhindi, Brinjal, Bush Cowpea, Chilly, Ginger, Tapiaco, Turmeric, Amaranthus in 0.5 cent of land or 25 grow bags in their house premise. For the second semester, the students have to prepare organic manure making out of kitchen waste or garden waste. The students are doing their project very successfully. Dr Roni Jain Raju, is the Co-Ordinator of this programme and there are 10 faculty mentors for giving assistance to the students for doing the MOOC Course.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES -KNOWLEDGE VILLAGE PROJECT

The mentors are selected from different universities in India ranging from University of Delhi, University of Kannur, University of Kerala, Mahatma Gandhi University.

Placement Drive was organized by Career Guidance and Placement cell with Educational Gamers Private Limited for the job openings as Content Developer and Content Presenter for their newly developed educational App MY EDGA. The venue for the placement drive is in college campus and students from other colleges participated for the placement drive. The drive is organized in 3 different rounds. For the final round 18 students are shortlisted and 3 students are finally selected.
