Association Inauguration

Our Chief guest was Prof V K Premnath, Retired faculty, Department of Physics, St. Thomas college, Rani. Head of the department Prof. Bini B. Nair delivered a warm welcome speech. She introduced our chief guest cited some of his achievements. Our principal Dr. Abraham V. Kuriakose presided the meeting. Next was the inaugural session. Premnath sir lighted the lamp and inaugurated the session.

The Regional workshop on Innovations in physics in the year 2015 (RWIP-2015) was conducted on 6th and 7th of August 2015. Asst. Prof. Merin Jose was the faculty

coordinator. The inaugural meeting was at the seminar hall. Our principal Dr. Abraham V. Kuriakose presided over the function and the college manager Chev. Prof. Prasad Joseph Koikal inaugurated the workshop. Ms. Amala Rajan delivered the vote of thanks.

The workshop was a great success as more than 200 students from various schools participated. Our own degree and pg students demonstrated almost all the experiments which are mentioned in school text books. We invited plus two and plus one students from nearby schools. In this year, the students were from four different schools (Ebenzer Higher secondary school, Ranni, Citadal Residential school, Ranni, SCVHSS, Kottanadu and SC HSS Ranny) and they took part in the workshop with much enthusiasm. Our students had arranged the demonstration of 20 electronics and general experiments, a documentary on astronomy in the dark room. On both days the programme ended by 3:30 in the evening.
