



## Action Taken Report

It is evident from the analysis on feedback collected from stakeholders on curriculum that they are satisfied with the curriculum structure. 25% students were not satisfied with teaching methods employed and the co-curricular ambience of the college. Teachers have an opinion to tune the syllabus to suit the need of the time. Only 10% of parents expressed their disagree regarding the productivity of the current semester system. Around 10% of alumni suggested that the applicability of the course cannot meet the real-life situations.

- We are changing the teaching method as student centric and activity based.
- Seminars, workshops, hands-on training, industrial visit/ Institution visit etc are conducted to improve the productivity of semester system.
- More national and international trips are planned
- With collaboration of Alumni more placement opportunities are likely to be provided


